

Buzz –Word Bingo

The Game

Wildlife management can often be a shotgun marriage between hard biological science and soft human interests. Progress can be difficult and frustrating, which sometimes leads to fairly content-free statements and long, pointless meetings.

By paying careful attention to the use of common buzz-words you will indirectly be able to gauge whether a speaker is saying something meaningful without having to put any effort into really listening.

Your interest and attention at meetings will increase dramatically and you will actually look forward to boring and long-winded meetings.

Included are 5 playing cards for players aged 5 and up. Please enjoy!!

How to play

- Print out and distribute the cards before a meeting.
- Listen for and mark off your squares as they come up.
- Players cannot contribute buzz-words during the meeting, unless, in a desperate attempt to win, you are able to use at least THREE (3) buzz-words in a single sentence.
- The winner is the first person to get a line of five buzz-words, horizontally, vertically or diagonally, interrupts the speaker and says, loudly and without a trace of a smile “I WHOLEHEARTEDLY CONCUR!”. (or BINGO!!)
